Scripture: 1 Corinthians 3:16-17, Galatians 5:19-25



Socially distant, spiritually connected - This week we want to remain connected to each other through prayer and study, even though we may be physically distant from each other. Take time to call people in your small group and talk with them about this week's message or tonight's bible study. You are invited to take out a journal and record your thoughts through this bible study and share them with others!

1. Prayer
 - a. Thank God for today and all that you got to enjoy as part of it
 - b. Pray for people you love and the people you have trouble loving
 - c. Ask God's help during this COVID-19 pandemic - for you, for our city, for our world
 - d. Pray for our leaders - government and church
 - e. Ask God to help you minister to those around you in the best possible way
2. **What are your most cherished memories from church life? Have you ever had any bad experiences with Christians or people in church? How did you handle those?**
 - a. Read Galatians 5:19-25
3. Watch tonight's Bible Study video over at churchonthedrive.org/connect/studies/
 - a. Read 1 Corinthians 3:16-17
4. Reflection
 - a. **What should the response of Christians, as the temple of God, be to acts of injustice? How has the Holy Spirit moved you to respond specifically when you see injustice?**
 - b. **Does physical health play a role in being the "temple of God"? If so, how?**
 - c. **What fruit of the spirit are most evident in your life? Are there any that might need more development? What can you do to ensure those fruit begin to blossom?**
5. This week's challenge: Ask people you trust to give you honest feedback about the presence of the fruit of the spirit in your life. Ask which ones they see most evident and which ones you still have the opportunity to showcase a little more. Then act on that information!
6. Pray for Church on the Drive and your loved ones. Pray for our community. Pray for our medical professionals and our country as communities begin reopening.
