1. Prayer

- c. Ask God's help during this COVID-19 pandemic for you, for our city, for our world
- d. Pray for our leaders government and church
- e. Ask God to help you use your influence for the Kingdom of love and light
- 2. Read Acts 16: 6-10 and 16:13-15 for context for tonight's study.

4. Reflection

- a. Who do you know that consistently uses their influence to spread love and light? What gives you that impression about them?
- b. Do you feel you've been able to resist frustration over the Pandemic? Why or why not?
- c. Who have you told lately about your reactions to the Pandemic? Do you seek God's help in dealing with it?
- 5. This week's challenge: Identify a person you feel is showing Christian kindness and ask how they go about it during today's trying times. Put into practice some of what they do and see if it makes a real difference in your life as you follow Jesus.
