Scripture: Luke 14:7-14, 13:22-30

1. Prayer
 - a. Thank God for today and all that you got to enjoy as part of it
 - b. Pray for people you love and the people you have trouble loving
 - c. Ask God's help during this COVID-19 pandemic - for you, for our city, for our world
 - d. Pray for our leaders - government and church
 - e. Ask God to help you minister to those around you in the best possible way
2. Read Luke 14:7-11 for context for tonight's study.
3. Watch tonight's Bible Study video over at churchonthedrive.org/connect/studies/
 - a. Read Luke 13:22-30 and 14:12-14
4. Reflection
 - a. **What does it mean to you to take the low place?**
 - b. **Who do you know that embodies the type of humility that Jesus describes? How might you take on their level of humility?**
 - c. **What are some recent opportunities you have had to take the low place?**
5. This week's challenge: Look for every opportunity to take the low place that you can find in one day. Make this your focus that day. Talk with a friend or a spouse or community group member about how your day went.
6. Pray for Church on the Drive and your loved ones. Pray for our community. Pray for followers of Jesus to be the personification of the love of God to the oppressed.
